

Evaluation of treatment outcome the Buddhist temple treatment center, Tam Kraborg

ABSTRACT

The cohort study was performed during 20 October 1976-February 1977. In this study, the percentage of heroin users from Bangkok was higher than from other provinces. Report of opium use revealed a reversing pattern. Further study on the base line data suggested that heroin users were young adults, age between 15-25 years of urban areas and exhibited a rather unstable socio-economic status. In information from the mail follow-up in the form of a self-report questionnaire postcard and the intensive case follow-up of the Bangkok cohort and other provinces cohorts were gathered. Finally, selected demographic characteristic data (figures, tables) of heroin users and opium smokers at The Buddhist Temple Treatment Center, Tam Kraborg were also illustrated.
